Ricky and Heather Lundholm are excited to serve with Mission Aviation Fellowship to bring the love of Jesus Christ to remote peoples where His name has never been heard. As a pilot/mechanic, Ricky looks forward to providing a vital service for missionaries and humanitarian workers by providing transportation that saves them days or weeks of travel by foot.

Ricky grew up in the small town of Payson in the mountains of northern Arizona. He grew to know and love Jesus Christ through the influence of his high school friends and youth pastor, who invited him into their group. It was there that he learned about the wonderful news of the Gospel and placed his life in Jesus' hands.

Ricky attended Arizona State University and graduated in 2003 with a bachelor's degree in interdisciplinary studies. Through his involvement in Campus Crusade for Christ, a campus ministry, Ricky became aware of the need for missions. A very influential moment was when someone handed him a list of people groups, still considered un-reached with the Gospel. He was shocked to see about forty pages each with about one hundred groups listed. As a senior in college he first heard about MAF. Learning more through their website, he was amazed at the strong impact they have to help bring the Gospel to isolated people. He had an immediate and strong excitement and desire to serve with MAF. That day Ricky identified with Isaiah, *“Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, ‘Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?’ And I said, ‘Here I am. Send me!’”* Isaiah 6:8

From 2006 to 2008, Ricky attend the School of Missionary Aviation Technology near Grand Rapids,

Michigan, earning his airframe and powerplant mechanic's license, commercial pilot's license, and flight instructor and instrument instructor ratings. He worked as a flight instructor to obtain additional experience required for MAF.

Heather was born and raised in Weston, Missouri. Through the influence of her church and youth ministries in high school and college, Heather discovered how to have a relationship with Christ and walk with Him. She attended the University of Missouri in Columbia, Missouri, earning a B.S. in Early Childhood Education in 2003. She was especially impacted by the ministry of Campus Crusade for Christ and women in her sorority who modeled authentic Christ-centered lives. During college she also learned more about mission opportunities overseas when she went on mission trips to Spain and a remote village in Jamaica. She met Ricky through Campus Crusade and they were married in 2004. Learning about MAF from Ricky, she was equally excited about the various ways they minister to unreached people groups.

In addition to caring for their daughter, Elise, Heather is excited to serve alongside Ricky, ministering through MAF.

MAF deploys a full range of aviation, communications, and distance education services to maximize ministry throughout Asia, Africa, Eurasia, and Latin America.

- ✦ Every **6 minutes**, in some of the most remote places on earth, an MAF aircraft either takes off or lands.
- ✦ More than **54,187** pounds of precious mission cargo are delivered daily to help God's Kingdom. A single MAF flight can haul one-half ton of supplies, more than a train of pack animals.
- ✦ Each day, some **673 passengers** are transported, including evangelists, teachers, medical personnel, indigenous pastors, church planters, community development workers, relief personnel, children, and those who are critically ill and in need of emergency medical assistance.
- ✦ **Every flight hour saves three days** of travel by foot or slow, arduous ground transportation ... greatly maximizing the ministry of missionaries and indigenous evangelists.
- ✦ An MAF airplane is **often the only safe and reliable means of transportation** for ministry activities, reducing an all-day trek by foot to a mere 20-minute flight.
